It is our responsibility to exercise tino rangatiratanga, to protect our cultural identity and authority as kaitiaki of our rohe, and to build the capability of our whanau, hapū and marae so we achieve optimal quality of life.

- Protect our culture and tribal identity
- Develop relationships that build socio-economic independence
- Retain customary authority and protect our resources
